04. The new Academic Session will commence from Thursday, 4 April, 2024 for all the classes including Kindergarten Classes. It is mandatory for all the students to be present on the first day of the new Academic Session. Absentees on the first day without prior permission will find their names struck off the school rolls.

Classes XI and XII:

Summer: From 07.25 a.m. to 11.15 a.m.

Winter: From 08.25 a.m. to 12.05 p.m.

- I request the parents to kindly abide by the school timings mentioned above and ensure that your ward(s) is/are punctual and regular to the school. Keeping in mind the safety and smooth running of the school, the school gates will be closed at 7.25 a.m. in summer & 8.25 in winter. Only in case of any unforeseen situation or emergency, parents/registered guardians need to inform the school authority and get the necessary permission for your ward/s coming late to the school or getting leave sanctioned.
- Parents are requested to read the rules and regulations mentioned in the school diary. **Every pupil must possess a copy of the school diary which should be brought to the school every day.** Apart from legibly entering the name and other personal data, pupil should not enter in it anything except what relates to school work. **Parents are requested to follow the communication done through E-Care portal.**
- As you are aware of the rising demands of the contemporary age and increasing cost of things, we have to increase the salaries of our teachers and other necessary infrastructure; hence, there will be a marginal increase in fee as per the Fee Regulatory Act. We request you to kindly cooperate.
- Students should be ready with their set of books, notebooks/stationery on the reopening day of the school and the books are covered neatly and labelled.
