- 04. The new Academic Session will commence from Saturday, 5 April, 2025 for all the classes including Kindergarten Classes. It is mandatory for all the students to be present on the first day of the new Academic Session. Absentees on the first day without prior permission will find their names struck off the school rolls.

- ➤ I request the parents to kindly abide by the school timings mentioned above and ensure that your ward(s) is/are punctual and regular to the school.
